NAVY PERSONNEL IN HAMPTON ROADS DELAYED THURSDAY

Norfolk, VA (CNRMA) – Due to continued inclement weather and flooding throughout the Hampton Roads area, Commander, Navy Region Mid-Atlantic has authorized a two hour delay tomorrow for Non-Mission Essential personnel at some Navy Installations in Hampton Roads. All Mission Essential Personnel are to report on time. Additionally, Liberal Leave for civilian personnel is authorized tomorrow.

Norfolk Naval Shipyard, Naval Medical Center Portsmouth and Naval Support Activity Hampton Roads - Portsmouth Annex personnel should report to work as scheduled.
