

Tenant Command Medical Home Port

Norfolk Naval Station tenant commands will soon be re-aligned into designated Medical Home Port teams at Branch Health Clinic Naval Station Norfolk.

Each tenant command will be assigned to its own Medical Home Port team. Nearly 13,000 active duty members will be affected, and enrollment letters should arrive in the mail starting mid-May 2014.

Command assignment by Medical Home Port teams provides greater continuity of care and access, and will streamline overall command and individual medical readiness.

Family members will not be affected by this change.

Prohibited Items

The following items are NOT allowed on Naval Station Norfolk at ANY TIME, unless you are in the discharge of official duties: handgun/firearms, rifles, shot guns (real or look-a-likes) anything that shoots projectiles, sling shots, blow guns, pellet guns, BB guns, air guns, knives (with a locking blade that measures 3 inches in length or longer) double sided blades, switch blades, martial arts paraphernalia, bow & arrows, just to name a few.

In short... ANY weapon which could be used to jeopardize the peace and security of Naval Station Norfolk.
