





COMMANDING OFFICER'S CY 2013
SAFETY PROGRAM GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

GOAL: Continue to improve our Volunteer Protection Program (VPP) Star safety culture by focusing on aggressive hazard elimination, safety training, and work process improvement:

- Maintain injuries and illnesses below (North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) code 561210 Government Base Facilities Operation Support Services) for the TCIR of 3.7 and the DART of 1.9.
- Reduce muscle strain and contact with object injuries by 25 percent compared to 2012.
- Ensure that all Management Assessment Program self safety inspections are completed during their assigned months.
- Strive to maintain a 95 - 99 percent Enterprise Safety Application Management System safety training completion rate.
- Complete all Annual Navy Occupational Safety and Health Inspections in the scheduled months.
- Strive to abate 90 percent of all open deficiencies within 30 days, and establish adequate interim controls as soon as deficiencies are noted.
- Review all deficiencies identified for possible trends and aggressively work to mitigate any trends that were discovered.
- Work to ensure all unsafe working conditions and near misses are reported preferably the same day.
- Work to ensure that all employees are familiar with the hazards listed in the most recent Industrial Hygiene Survey for their work area.
- Ensure fire drills and emergency evacuation training is provided to all employees of occupied buildings at least annually.
- Ensure that current emergency evacuations plans are displayed near high traffic areas of all occupied buildings.
- Complete/update all Job Hazard Analyses as needed but at least annually.
- Continue to mentor supervisors and employees on safety and the VPP.
- Recognize personnel for safety excellence.
