AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL

Personnel authorized to use MWR activities include active duty members and their families, reserve members, retired military personnel and their dependents, medal of honor recipients and their surviving spouses and family members, unremarried surviving spouses of retired military personnel and their family members, academy midshipmen and cadets, ROTC cadets when on active duty during college vacation, drilling members of reserve components and dependents, NAF employees of the MWR Dept., NAS JAX DoD employees and other NAF employees of NAS JAX and the family member of the above.

MWR ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE: (904) 542-3111

Located in Bldg. 1 on Langley Street, this office includes the MWR Installation Program Director and Operations Manager, Administration, Marketing Director, Personnel and the Business Manager.

MARKETING & SPONSORSHIP: (904) 542-8205

Located in Bldg. 1 on Langley Street, this office is the information center for the MWR Department. The Marketing Director is the point of contact for sponsorship, special events, indoctrinations, command briefs and homecomings. Annual special events include the Navy Run, Month of the Military Child Carnival, Military Family Appreciation Carnival, intramural tournaments, concerts and much more. RECYCLING CENTER: (904) 542-3113

Located in Bldg. 623 on Birmingham Ave. between Gillis and Jason Streets. The center takes office paper (colored and white), newspaper, computer paper and cards, cardboard, car batteries, plastic (including bottles), glass (clear, brown and green) and aluminum cans. Squadrons, commands and departments are encouraged to drop off all recyclables at the Recycling Center. Used automotive oil is accepted at the Auto Skills Center during business hours only.



CHILD AND YOUTH PROGRAMS



CHILD DEVELOPMENT HOME: (904) 542-5381

The Child Development Home Program is an extension of the Child Development Program located in Bldg. 2070. Child Development Homes (CDH) are independent business enterprises operated by Navy certified military family members in their own homes.

The CDH program has an open door policy and allows young children to receive the same early start in learning just as the CDC provides, but in a home like environment while providing continued support to parents and military readiness. Providers may live either on or off base and may care for up to six children (including their own) under the age of eight. Some providers operate infant-only homes, allowing a provider to care for only 3 children under the age of 24 months (including their own children). Providers must maintain current CPR and First Aid certification, maintain current liability insurance and pass monthly inspections by the CDH Director/Monitor. They also prepare meals in accordance with the USDA Food Program guidelines. Providers receive continuous monthly trainings on age appropriate activities for young children and professional ethics. The Commanding Officer has the final authority to certify all CDH homes on and off base.



A subsidy program is available to provide weekly rates that are similar to those of the CDC for children 6 weeks to 12 years of age. Subsidy rates are available to parents that have been referred to CDH providers from the Central Enrollment Waiting List (CEWL). The CDH program offers full day, hourly, drop-ins, before and after school, special needs, weekends, and night care. All rates are determined by total family income.

CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER: (904) 542-5529

The Child Development Program provides full-time and drop-in care. The CDC is located in Bldg. 2070 and is open from 6 a.m. – 6 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding federal holidays. Full-time care comprises the majority of care provided and it includes breakfast, lunch and an afternoon snack. The fee structure for full-

time care is based on total family income as regulated by Department of Defense instructions. Hourly or drop-in care is limited due to space availability. Reservations are required and can be made up to 30 days in advance. Hourly care is available for ages 6 weeks - 5 years based on availability. Priority for full-time care is given to single and dual military families.

This program is based on the National Association for the Education of Young Children's guidelines on Developmentally Appropriate Practice in Early Childhood Programs and strives to promote the physical, social, emotional, and cognitive development of children, while responding to the needs of the family. Activities children have the opportunity to participate in include: creative art, music, fine and gross motor skills development,

sand and water play, songs and finger plays, story times, readiness skills for math, reading and writing, dramatic play and activities to promote positive social skills and self image. Children have free choice in selecting activities. Children will be involved in “play” and will learn the following: selecting, experimenting, classifying, measuring, discussing, validating, enjoying, participating, testing, questioning, organizing, observing, improving, discovering and construction.

YOUTH ACTIVITIES & PROGRAMS: (904) 778-9772

Located in Bldg. 2069 on Mustin Road this program consists of many different activities to accommodate military and DoD dependents ages kindergarten through 18 years. Open recreation and Friday night events are popular programs and feature a variety of activities designed for individual age groups. Youth Activities offers special programs for teens only. Additional programs and special events offered by Youth Activities include: Night Easter Egg Hunt, Month of the Military Child Carnival, Navy Family Day Carnival, fitness programs and much more!



SCHOOL-AGE CARE PROGRAM: (904) 778-9772

The School-Age Care Program is available for dependents of military and DoD personnel for children ages kindergarten through 12 years. Trained counselors help children with homework, arts and crafts, nature, and other activities. All counselors have experience in childhood education and are CPR and first aid certified.

SCHOOL LIAISON OFFICE: (904) 778-2236

Located close to base housing in Bldg. 2065, the School Liaison Office is the communications and service link between the base Commanding Officer, commands, military families and schools including public, private, home school, Department of Defense Education Activity and online schools. The School Liaison Officer serves as the military installation subject matter expert for youth education issues. They provide support and assistance to military families and Department of Defense employees in the areas of education. They represent the needs of the military child by developing collaborative solutions with local schools to overcome barriers to successful school transitions.

CAMPS: (904) 778-9772

Spring Break Day Camp, Summer Day Camp and Holiday Camp are three of the many programs provided by the Youth Activities Center. Summer Camp is 10 weeks and includes swimming, arts and crafts, nature hikes, bowling and field trips. Camp is 6 a.m. – 6 p.m., Monday through Friday.

FITNESS, AQUATICS AND SPORTS



GYMNASIUM: (904) 542-3239/2930

Located in Bldg. 614 on Gillis Street, the Gymnasium offers exercise and aerobic fitness equipment. There are weight rooms, complete with Olympic weights, dumbbells and benches. Also available are male and female steam and sauna rooms. The facility includes a basketball court, three racquetball courts as well as athletic gear available such as towels and sports equipment. Lockers are available on a daily or monthly basis.

The Athletic Office, located in the Gym, is the center for all types of sports programs. Intramural Sports available include: softball, flag football, golf, tennis, racquetball, basketball, indoor volleyball, sand volleyball and soccer. Most sports are offered twice a year and there is a fierce competition for the coveted Captain's Cup, awarded annually to the top command. Many special events are offered such as softball tournaments, 5K monthly runs/walks and the Annual Navy 10K Run/5K Walk.



MCCAFFREY SOFTBALL COMPLEX: (904) 542-2930

The McCaffrey Complex features four playing fields, each with a 275-foot fence, spectator bleaches, restroom facilities, second floor scorers and announcer's booths for all fields and electronic scoreboards on fields two and four. The complex is utilized throughout the year by intramural leagues, graybeard leagues and various tournaments. McCaffrey Softball Complex also offers a concession stand which serves food and beverages available for purchase.



FITNESS SOURCE: (904) 542-3518

Located in Bldg. 867 on Enterprise Avenue, this high-tech facility is free for active duty service members, family members, reservists, retirees and authorized civilian patrons. The facility offers a complete line of cardio and strength training equipment.



The cardio area offers treadmills, stair steppers, step mills, Ellipticals, stationary and recumbent bikes. Most of the cardio equipment is connected to a cardio theater which allows enjoyment of a wide array of television channels and radio stations while working out.

There are two separate strength training areas. One is the free weight area which offers Olympic free weights. The other area offers two complete lines of Nautilus and Cybex strength training equipment.

Qualified instructors offer a variety of aerobics, kickboxing, pilates, yoga and step classes various days throughout the week.

FAMILY FITNESS CENTER: (904) 778-9772/542-2930

The Family Fitness Center is located above the Youth Center Gym in Bldg. 2069. The Family Fitness program provides an environment for promoting healthier lifestyles to families in the NAS Jacksonville community. The goal of the center is to keep the entire family healthy by providing an environment for families to meet their fitness needs, in a family friendly atmosphere. A Qualified Fitness Instructor/trainer will be available to assist patrons with their fitness goals. The center offers a full circuit of Life Fitness equipment.



INDOOR POOL: (904) 542-2930/3239


Inside the Base Gym, the indoor swimming pool is 50 meters by 25 yards with a graduated depth to 12 feet. The pool also serves as a training area for military requirements. Year-round activities include aqua aerobics, swim lessons, scuba lessons, recreational swimming and lifeguard training courses.

OUTDOOR POOL: (904) 542-3720

The outdoor swimming pool is adjacent to Bldg. 419 on Allegheny Street and is open on a seasonal basis. The pool is 50 meters by 25 yards with a graduated depth to six feet. The facility includes a bathhouse and shower.

The Outdoor Pool offers a variety of swim lessons for all ages, aqua aerobic classes and lifeguard training. Pool parties are also available.

RECREATION AND SERVICES



MULBERRY COVE MARINA: (904) 542-3260

The Marina is located on the south end of Ranger Road, along the banks of the beautiful St. John's River. The Marina store offers bait, ice, sandwiches, beer, soda, fishing licenses, fishing tackle, sunglasses, tee shirts, outdoor recreation knives, basic boat parts, and various sundries to meet boating needs. The Marina also has non-ethanol marine grade gasoline pier-side and a free boat ramp.

For boat owners, there are slips, moorings and dry storage available on a daily, monthly and yearly rental basis. Fresh water and 30-amp and 50-amp station power are available at the slips. Live-aboards are only permitted on a temporary basis.

Sailing instruction classes and stand up paddle board lessons are also available. The Marina offers a wide array of rental equipment including kayaks, canoes, surfboards, stand up paddle boards, fishing kayaks, and Flying Scot sailboats. Powerboats include pontoon boats, Boston Whalers, 14-foot Trackers and Edgewater Center Consoles with fish finders.

Reservations for powerboats must be made in person with a \$25 deposit.

The Marina also rents tents, sleeping pads, cots, camp stoves, lanterns, large grills, coolers and turkey fryers.

FISHING: (904) 542-3260

Fishing is permitted on the north side of Casa Linda Lake (catch and release only) and in the St. John's River. Fishing is not permitted from the piers at Mulberry Cove Marina. A Florida fishing license is required for anyone ages 15-65.

Fishing licenses are available at the Mulberry Cove Marina.

PICNIC AREAS: (904) 542-3260

Several beautiful parks and picnic grounds are scattered around the base. Most of these grounds are equipped with shelters, restrooms, barbeque pits, ball fields and playground equipment. Reservations are required and can be made up to six months in advance.

LIBERTY RECREATION CENTER: (904) 542-1335/3491

This high-tech recreation center, located in Bldg. 816, is designed to meet the needs of the E1-E6 Single Sailors and Geographical Bachelors living on board NAS Jacksonville. The Liberty Recreation Center contains Internet access computers, Sony Play Stations, Xbox 360's, WiFi, movie viewing area, and a variety of recreational equipment including pool, ping-pong, an outdoor basketball court and more. Everything in the center is open to active duty and is free of charge. The hours of operation are Monday through Sunday 10 a.m. – midnight (7 days/week).



The Liberty Recreation Center is open 365 days of the year and it also offers a variety of off base trips to amusements parks, professional sports games, St. Augustine, Daytona Beach, concerts, water parks and more!

GOLF COURSE & PRO SHOP: (904) 542-3249

Located in Bldg. 809 on Mustin Rd., NAS Jacksonville Golf Course offers 27 holes of championship golf for all ages and skill levels. The Red and White courses are each a Par 36, while the Blue Course is a Par 35. The Red and White course plays to a demanding 6,890 yards, Par 72. The addition of the new White Course has added to the landscape of the original Red and Blue Courses. The holes wind through beautiful tree-lined fairways that are complimented with rich blue lakes. A full practice facility is available, as well as a PGA Professional Staff to meet every golf need. It is one of the finest golf courses in the Jacksonville area.



INFORMATION, TICKETS & TRAVEL (ITT): (904) 542-3318

The Information Tickets and Travel Program offers discount ticket sales for special events as well as area attractions, hotel information and cruise booking. Also offered are regional brochures as well as information, monthly bus tours with a 24- passenger tour bus and other special services. Military, Retired, Dependents, DoD civilians and all MWR authorized patrons can purchase tickets. All prices include surcharge. ITT is conveniently located in front of the Navy Exchange in Building 953-A. VISA, MasterCard, American Express and Discover are accepted.



NAVY FLYING CLUB: (904) 777-8549/8541

The JAX Navy Flying Club (JNFC) is located in Bldg. 847A on the north side of the main runway. For the first visit to this facility, you must be escorted. JNFC offers courses designed for one to obtain FAA ratings from Private Pilot license through Airline Transport Pilot. All JNFC training is FAA Part 141 and VA approved.



In addition to ground and flight instruction, the club offers aircraft checkouts and rentals, flight reviews, instrument proficiency checks and recurrent training in areas requested by club members. The organization is a sponsored club and members must be active duty military, reservist, National Guard, retired military, dependent, Civil Air Patrol or a DoD employee.

NAS FREEDOM LANES & PRO SHOP: (904) 542-3493

The Bowling Center is located on Gillis Street in Bldg. 609. The facility is 24-lanes with automatic scoring and automatic bumpers for children. The flooring to the bowling lanes is a flush surface which makes it easily accessible for children and



the young at heart. The center offers open bowling, league bowling and Xtreme bowling, a high energy bowling experience with music and lights. The Gutterball Grill, a snack bar, is located in the Bowling Center and serves food, alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages daily. Other events include daily specials, summer and winter leagues, intramural leagues, young at heart leagues, command functions and birthday parties. The center also has a pro shop with professional fitting and drilling service. Individual or group lessons are available.

OUTDOOR FIELDS & COURTS: (904) 542-3239/2930

Several fields and courts are scattered around the base that are available for commands to utilize. Commands wishing to reserve court/field space in advance may do so through the base gym.

TENNIS: (904) 542-3239/2930

Six lighted and two non-lighted tennis courts are located near the Birmingham Gate and no reservations are needed. Two additional lighted tennis courts are located at the Visitor's Quarters on Mustin Road.

PRT CENTER: (904) 542-3239/2930

Located at Bldg. 10-A off Mustin Road, the PRT Center offers bathroom facilities, a changing area and showers 24 hours a day.

VETERINARY TREATMENT FACILITY: (904) 542-3786

The Veterinary Treatment Facility, provided by the Army Veterinary Service Department, is located at Bldg. 537 Biscayne Street. The clinic offers veterinary

preventive services including parasites and heartworms, micro chipping, and minor sick call appointments. A wide range of flea control products, shampoos and other items are available. Pets are seen by appointment only and veterinary service is available to pets owned by active duty and retired personnel, his or her dependents and reservists on active duty. Housing residents

may keep cats and dogs in their homes if they are registered with the clinic, have up to date vaccinations, are micro-chipped and spayed or neutered.

NAS JAX BINGO: (904) 542-5007

The Grand Ballroom, located in Dewey's, houses both a lunch and an evening program of Bingo! Lunchtime Bingo is played Monday through Friday 11:15 a.m. - 1:00 p.m and Evening Bingo is Sunday, Monday, Tuesday and Thursday at 6:30 p.m.

AUTOS AND RV'S



AUTO SKILLS CENTER: (904) 542-3227

The Auto Skills Center is a large, complete auto workshop, located at Bldg. 622 on Birmingham, has wheel balancing, 22 work bays, tool checkout, paint booth and welding. An ASE-certified master mechanic is available on a regular basis and an in-house safety test is mandatory before participation. Long pants and shoes are required. For safety reasons, children under the age of 16 are not permitted in or around the facility at any time. For the Deployed Storage, Storage Lot, Autorama Resale Lot, call the Auto Skills Center.

RV PARK

Forty-four sites are located on the corner of Birmingham Avenue and Mustin Road overlooking the St. John's River. The park offers discounted weekly rates, 28 full sites (sewer, water and electric), 9 partial sites (water, electric), and 7 primitive sites. Shower and restroom facilities are available on premises.

Reservations are made at the Auto Skills Center or by calling (904) 542-5898 for site information. The R.V. Park is part of Navy Getaways.

CAR WASH

Located behind the Auto Skills Center between Gillis and Jason Streets, this self-service facility is open 24 hours. The car wash offers three wash bays and heavy-duty vacuums, power wands and brushes, towel dispenser and other amenities, such as fragrance and protectors.



DEPLOYED STORAGE (FOR VEHICLES)

This is a secured lot that allows storage from overnight to six months for deployments and for hospitalizations in excess of 30 days.

STORAGE LOT (FOR VEHICLES, RV'S, TRAILERS)

Gated storage with 24-hours access. Rates are either on a monthly or yearly basis.

AUTORAMA RESALE LOT

The Autorama Resale lot is located on Birmingham Avenue. *Vehicles, campers and boats for the resale lot are registered at the Auto Skills Center.*

LODGING



HERITAGE COTTAGES: (904) 542-3138/3139

The Heritage Cottages are 16 furnished units available at very affordable prices. The Cottages feature two-bedroom, one bath and sleep up to six, fully furnished kitchen, screened porch, TVs, DVD players, Wi-Fi and bedding. Conveniently located adjacent to the golf course and across from the Naval Hospital, the Cottages are within walking distance or a short ride of the Base NEX, Commissary and MWR facilities.

RESTAURANTS AND CATERING



MULLIGAN'S RESTAURANT & BAR: (904) 542-2936

This all-hands food operation is located in Bldg. 809 on Mustin Road inside the golf clubhouse. It services daily customers as well as golf food functions and small social events. An attractive setting offers a dramatic view overlooking the golf course. This full-service eatery offers breakfast from 6:30 a.m. – 10:00 a.m. and daily lunch specials. Social hours are held every Wednesday and Friday beginning at 4 p.m.

GUTTERBALL GRILL: (904) 542-3295

The Gutterball Grill is located in the Bowling Center, Bldg. 609, on Gillis Street. The Grill is a snack bar which serves breakfast, lunch and dinner, as well as alcoholic and nonalcoholic beverages daily. The Grill offers daily lunch specials; Dine-In or Take-Out is available.
