JBPHH to conduct force protection drill on Mar. 12

PEARL HARBOR-HICKAM - Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam will conduct a force protection drill on the afternoon of Mar. 12 that will involve brief closures of the gates to the main installation. Inbound and outbound traffic to the main JBPHH installation will be affected by brief closures of Halawa, Makalapa, Nimitz, O'Malley and Kuntz gates beginning at about 1:30 p.m. to last approximately 15 minutes. Ford Island and Borchers gates will remain open as normal. The drill will not affect Ford Island and Makalapa compounds, and the annexes at West Loch, Lualualei or Wahiawa.

During the drill, base residents shall continue to conduct business as normal but are cautioned to adjust their schedules to avoid entering or exiting the gates during the drill. As part of the exercise, JBPHH will broadcast messages via Giant Voice mass notification system towers, which may be audible to off-base residents living near the base.
