

This information flyer is created to assist you with waste container processing on the Naval Air Station, Corpus Christi. The Station's Hazardous Waste Commodities Branch (HWCB) will provide empty containers and pick-up full containers for all activities on Station. For further assistance please contact the HWCB at 961-4089/4094/3760.

Container Issuing Process

1. Know the size, type, and quantity of container(s) you need
2. If this container is for an established Satellite Accumulation Point (SAP) please provide the SAP number
3. Your contact information (name/number)
4. Provide waste profile, if applicable
5. Specific location you'd like the container delivered
6. Send an e-mail with the above information to NAVFACSEPWDCORPUSHWCB@navy.mil
7. HWCB will label and mark containers before delivery, each container will be issued an independent Waste Tracking Number (WTN), this number will be used to turn in the container.

Container Pick-up Process

1. Ensure container has a current profile or Waste Identification (Form-2)
 2. In an e-mail to NAVFACSEPWDCORPUSHWCB@navy.mil please note the container WTN, Accumulation Start Date, your contact information and pick-up location. (please be specific as possible on the pick-up location)
- HWCB will pick-up containers within 3 days
 - HWCB will conduct inspection of container during pick-up, ensure compliance with the following or container will be rejected for pick-up
 - Properly close container
 - No evidence of waste on exterior of container
 - Label and markings on container not damaged or covered
 - Accumulation Start Date (ASD) is on container label
