JOINT BASE PEARL HARBOR-HICKAM INSTRUCTION 3171.2

Subj: HARBOR MOVEMENT INSTRUCTION

1. Purpose. To promulgate the requirements for submitting a request for all harbor movements within the Pearl Harbor Naval Defense Sea Area to include Small Boat Movements, Seal Delivery Vehicle Team One (SDVT-1) Movements, Divers, Swimmer Operations and Anti-Terrorism Force Protection (ATFP) Drills, Exercises and/or Training.

2. Cancellation. This instruction cancels and supersedes NAVSTAPEARLINST 3171.2

3. Action

a. Major Movements

(1) All major harbor movements will be scheduled at the weekly Harbor Movements Meeting (HMM), chaired by Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam (JBPHH) Port Operations every Tuesday at 0900 in Bldg 150, 1st Floor, Room 114 (Port Operations Conference Room). Major movements are defined as ships, submarines and SDVT-1. The following commands are required to have a representative present: JBPHH Harbor Security, COMNAVSURFGRU MIDPAC, COMDESRON THREE ONE, Naval Submarine Support Command

(NSSC), Military Sealift Command (MSC), SDVT-1 and Pearl Harbor Naval Shipyard. Any other commands requiring harbor movements are also required to attend. This meeting will produce the harbor movements message that will be transmitted Tuesday afternoon and contain movements for the next two weeks.

(2) Seal Delivery Vehicle movements must be closely monitored by Harbor Control to ensure the safe navigation of the units and to ensure there is no conflict with units transiting the channel. SDVT-1 will provide a detailed plan as outlined in enclosure (1) for each evolution to Port Operations via email at minimum one working day prior. These evolutions will be broken into two categories:

(a) Transit. Transits refer to the vehicle deploying from its location in the harbor or at buoys 1 and 2 and transiting straight to the pier or out of the harbor. This does not include any period where the unit may stop and conduct training.

(b) Training. Training refers to periods where the intention is to remain in the harbor and conduct various training evolutions. This category is further broken down into sub-categories based on the distance they intend to remain from other units transiting the channel.

1. Greater than 100 feet from another unit - these evolutions will be scheduled in the Port Operations Management Systems (POMS) via the evolution sheet provided.

2. Less than 100 feet from another unit - closing to within 100 feet constitutes the evolution being classified as an exercise. The evolution will not be scheduled until coordination with the other unit has been completed.

3. Effort should be made to submit any changes to approved evolutions, 24 hours in advance. Due to the nature of SDVT-1 vehicles, changes may be made up to three hours before the event as long as the basic track has no changes. Changes will not be approved until Port Operations personnel have been briefed and grant permission.

b. ATFP Drill/Exercise/Training

(1) Pearl Harbor provides a great opportunity to conduct ATFP Training for commands while moored or transiting the channel. Close coordination between all participants is key to conducting the evolutions in a safe manner. Commands desiring to conduct a training exercise should use enclosure (2) as a guide.

(2) Commands desiring to conduct an exercise on the water will submit a draft naval message to JBPHH Port Operations via email, at prlh-navstaharbormaster@navy.mil, per enclosure (3), no later than five working days prior to the date of the drill. This message will state the desired date, time, event, and location.

(3) No later than one working day prior to the event, those commands providing support services will schedule their assets (e.g. boat, swimmers) via email, at prlh-navstaharbormaster@navy.mil, with JBPHH Port Operations.

(4) Once the supported services have been scheduled, JBPHH Port Operations will assign a designator to the exercise and release the ALNAVACTS message. The designator will be based on the date and number of the event (e.g. 10-1).

(5) Changes to the date or time of an approved ATFP Drill/Exercise shall be submitted via email, at prlh-navstharbormaster@navy.mil, a minimum of three working days prior to the exercise. JBPHH Port Operations will make the appropriate changes and notifications.

(6) If the changes can be accommodated approval will be sent via email. If the change cannot be accommodated, JBPHH Port Operations will contact the requestor to work out arrangements and scheduling.

(7) Failure to adhere to enclosures (2) through (5) may result in disapproval of the request.

c. Small Boat/Divers/Swimmers

(1) All small boat movements being conducted in support of an exercise, drill (e.g. ATFP, VBSS), or multi-unit exercise must be scheduled one working day in advance by sending an email request in accordance with enclosure (5). All other small boat movements will be authorized by Pearl Harbor Control by requesting permission on Bridge-to-Bridge Channel 69 prior to movement.

(2) Emergency Boat Runs can be authorized by the Pearl Harbor Control watch stander. An emergency boat run is any run that is required to support a life threatening situation. Harbor Control will grant permission for the emergency run, then inform all units in the harbor of the even and delay/secure all movements in the harbor.

AT/FP DRILL/EXERCISE/TRAINING REQUEST CHECKLIST

5 WORKING DAYS PRIOR TO EVENT

___ Submit request for ATFP Drill/Exercise/Training with a draft ALNAVACTS message to JBPHH Port Operations via email, prlh-navstaharbormaster@navy.mil. Event designator will be assigned. ALNAVACTS message released at a minimum of 3 working days prior to event.

1 WORKING DAY PRIOR TO EVENT

___ Supporting commands schedule support movements with JBPHH Pearl Operations via email, prlh-navstaharbormaster@navy.mil. Information required: date, time, location and detailed description. See enclosure (5) for example.

___ JBPHH Port Operations approval/confirmation will be sent via email to requestor.

DAY OF EVENT

___ Request permission from Harbor Control via marine band radio for small boats to get underway and for divers or swimmers to enter the water. (Example: "Harbor Control this is ATG RHIB-1, request permission to get underway from Fox 1 in support of ATFP drill designation 07-01")

___ Harbor Control will reply back with the status of permission.

___ Officer Conducting Exercise (OCE) will notify all units of COMEX and FINEX of event using the following format: "This is the OCE for ALNAVACTS Drill Designation 07-01, event will be run on safety channel, all stations will also monitor channel 69. In the event of an actual casualty OCE will announce FINEX and allow casualty procedure to take place. All unit COMEX drill 07-01. All units FINEX drill 07-01."

___ If an event requires exiting the harbor outside of buoys 1 and 2, contact Pearl Harbor Control prior to exit/re-entry into Pearl Harbor via marine band radio.

___ Contact Pearl Harbor Control upon completion of evolution and when moored via marine band radio.

ALL WEAPONS WILL BE TRAINING RED OR BLUE GUNS WITH THE EXCEPTION OF CSW, WHICH WILL BE VERIFIED CLEAR AND SAFE BY ATTT AND TAPED AROUND END OF BARREL.

3. ATTT MEMBERS WILL SUPERVISE ARMED WATCHSTANDERS FOR SAFETY THROUGHOUT THE EXERCISE AND WILL BE DESIGNATED BY CAMOUFLAGE TRAINING TEAM COVERS. ATG AFTP TEAM WILL BE ON BOARD TO CONDUCT TRAINING FOR HOP DRILLING WATCHSTANDERS.//

**SMALL BOAT MOVEMENT/DIVERS/SWIMMERS
REQUEST CHECK OFF SHEET**

___ Commands requesting to schedule small boat movements for exercises or swimmers shall do so via email, prlh-navstaharbormaster@navy.mil to JBPHH Port Operations. Enclosure (5) provides the format to be used to schedule the event (minimum one working day prior to the event).

___ If able to accommodate the event, JBPHH Port Operations will notify requesting unit via email reply.

Day of Event

___ Request permission from Pearl Harbor Control via marine band radio for small boats to get underway and for divers or swimmers to enter the water. (Example: "Harbor Control this is USS Halsey RHIB, request permission to get underway from Whiskey-2 to Merry Point Landing for PAX transfer.")

___ Pearl Harbor Control will grant permission unless there is unexpected activity in the harbor or the event is not scheduled.

___ If an event requires exiting the harbor outside of buoys 1 and 2 contact Pearl Harbor control prior to exit/re-entry into Pearl Harbor via marine band radio. Units shall notify Harbor Control when they pass buoys 1 and 2 outbound, and request permission to enter the harbor prior to their return approach to buoys 1 and 2.

___ Contact Harbor Control upon completion of evolution and when moored via marine band radio.

Request(s) shall be made to JBPHH Port Operations via email during normal working hours Monday through Friday (except federal holidays), 0730-1530 at prlh-navstaharbormaster@navy.mil or phone, (808) 473-1168. After hours, on weekends or on holidays, request(s) should be made to JBPHH Harbor Control at (808) 474-6262.

EXAMPLE EMAIL REQUEST FOR SMALL BOAT MOVEMENT/DIVERS/SWIMMERS

The following information is required for the scheduling of small boat movements/diver/swimmer: date, time, location and a detailed description of the evolution requested, and shall be submitted via email at prlh-navstaharbormaster@navy.mil.
