DESCRIPTION:	<p>This workshop helps participants to develop greater inter-cultural understanding in the workplace. We will learn how to better understand, communicate, and work productively with persons of different cultures. The workshop will cover two folios of intercultural behavior and communication, such as 1) understanding of methodology of inter-cultural awareness and 2) the interpersonal communication strategy not being overwhelmed but staying alive in a difficult situation without getting ‘taken off’ or pushed aside. For instance, we learn that Stress and Difficulty tend to stem from ‘autopilot’ of our mind, in other words, ‘cognitive unconsciousness’, thereafter we learn behavioral change through interpersonal skills. ‘Awareness Wheel’ is another pillar to learn in view of problem solving. The training combines cognitive understanding, emotional insight, and behavioral change. We will pay special attention to emphasize skills and strategies that will better enable us to create a harmonious and efficient working situation.</p> <p><u>How Participants Will Benefit</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Learn about framework of the mind-sets toward cultural difference.● Learn about autopilot mindset and cognitive unconsciousness.● Learn key strategies to overcome barriers to effective intercultural interactions.● Understand the idea of ‘Deep Culture Onion’ to know what is in the surface and what is hidden in the deep scene to share the value.● Learn how to proceed with logical interpretation about the difference in behavior, business process, and even organization structure.● Learn about communication styles and strategy knowing differences of the people around.● Learn about ‘Work Communication’, i.e., productive communication skills on the job.● Develop greater understanding of problem solving in the workplace based on ‘Awareness Wheel’.● Gain insights for effective inter-cultural conflict management, prevention and solution.
