

Conservation Tips

Toilets:

- Would you drop a nickel in every time you flushed? Don't use them for waste baskets. Unnecessary flushes waste water and increase sewage costs. On average, one flush at CFAS is equal to about 3 gallons and costs close to 5 Cents (Water and Sewer Costs).

Washing Full Loads:

- Wash full loads and use cold water whenever possible. Each hot water load costs over 40 Cents at CFAS.

Lights Off.

- Leaving the room for more than 10 minutes? Save energy by turning off the lights. Where applicable, use day lighting, task lighting and de-lamping to save energy.


