

GRANDBERRY MALL by CAR or TRAIN

3-4-1 Tsuruma Machida-shi, Tokyo

GRANDBERRY MALL is an expansive outdoor shopping center. It includes many of the brand name stores you will find in a typical outlet center in the United States, but it also has many other variety of shops from pet stores to hair salons. It is divided into four zones: a family life themed zone, a fresh foods zone, an outlet mall zone, and a communication and entertainment zone.

BY CAR


From YOKOSUKA:

1. Turn right onto **Rt. 16** as you exit the main gate. After driving past Shoppers Plaza, move into the rightmost lane.
2. Drive up the ramp onto **HONCHO-YAMANAKA Toll Road** and pay ¥210 at the tollgate.
3. Keep left at the 1st Y-split and take **YOKOHAMA-YOKOSUKA Toll Road** toward **YOKOHAMA** direction.
4. Continue on Yokohama-Yokosuka Toll Rd. toward **HODOGAYA BYPASS/HACHIOJI** and pay ¥740 (¥700 from Zushi) at the Mutsukawa tollgate.
5. After the tollgate, the Yoko-Yoko Toll Rd. merges with Hodogaya Bypass then with Rt. 16. **Continue straight on Rt.16** toward **TOMEI EXPWY/HACHIOJI (八王子)**. Drive past the entrance for the Tomei Expressway and **stay in the left lane.**
6. After crossing **Rt. 246**, you will see a six-storied furniture store with a huge green sign  on its roof to your left.
7. **Turn left at the next intersection** with a pedestrian overpass. Follow the short narrow road, turn left, and proceed toward the entrance to Grandberry Mall.

BY TRAIN

From YOKOSUKA:

1. At **YOKOSUKA CHUO (横須賀中央) Station**, buy a **¥830** (¥780 from Ikego/Jimmuji Station) transfer ticket to **NAGATSUTA (長津田) Station** via the **JR YOKOHAMA Line (JR 横浜線)**.
****Note**** To buy a transfer ticket, touch the following buttons on the screen:
<<<English → Ticket → Connecting Ticket tab → Change at Yokohama JR Lines → Ticket fare amount>>>
2. Go to **Platform #2** and take a train with either a GREEN or RED Kanji sign bound for Yokohama/Shinagawa.
****Note**** **If possible, get on one of the last two cars of the train. This will make it easier and faster to find the entrance for the JR YOKOHAMA Line (GREEN-striped trains).**
3. Get off at **YOKOHAMA Station**, use the **CENTRAL EXIT (中央口) stairs**, follow the signs for the wicket machine entrance toward the JR Line platforms. **Do not forget to retrieve your ticket.** Go to **Platform #4** and take a **JR YOKOHAMA Line train (GREEN-striped train)** bound for Machida/Hachioji.
****Note****
~Both the **JR YOKOHAMA Line (green-striped trains)** and **JR KEIHIN-TOHOKU Line (blue-striped trains)** use **track # 4** alternately. **Make sure you take the correct train.**
~If in **YOKOHAMA Station BETWEEN 8am and 5pm**, take the **JR YOKOHAMA Line (green-striped trains)** from Yokohama Station, which runs about every 10 to 20 minutes.
~If in **YOKOHAMA Station BEFORE 8am or AFTER 5pm**, take the **JR KEIHIN-TOHOKU Line (blue-striped trains)** from Yokohama to **HIGASHI-KANAGAWA (東神奈川) Station (1st stop from Yokohama Station)**, then transfer to the **JR YOKOHAMA Line (green-striped trains) bound for Machida/Hachioji.**
4. Get off at **NAGATSUTA Station (9th stop from Yokohama)** and transfer to the **DEN-EN-TOSHI (田園都市) Line**.
5. Buy a second ticket for **¥160** ticket to **MINAMI-MACHIDA (南町田) Station** via the **DEN-EN-TOSHI Line**
6. Get off at **MINAMI-MACHIDA Station (3rd stop from Nagatsuta Station)**. The Grandberry Mall is just outside the station.
