NAVY RELEASES NEW ECONOMIC IMPACT REPORT FOR HAMPTON ROADS AREA

Norfolk, Va. – Commander, Navy Region Mid-Atlantic has released the fiscal year 2014 (Oct. 1, 2013 through Sept. 30, 2014) Department of the Navy impact statistical data for the Hampton Roads area.

Total direct economic impact for the area in FY14 was \$9.98 billion, an increase of approximately \$770 million over FY13. Annual payroll (military and civilian) saw an increase from \$7.8 billion to \$8.4 billion from FY13 to FY14. In addition, the procurement of goods and services saw an increase of nearly \$160 million, from \$1.3 billion in FY13 to \$1.46 billion in FY14.

Operationally, the number of ships home ported in Hampton Roads decreased from 76 to 70, however the number of aircraft squadrons increased by 1 from 38 to 39.

The report captures the amount of direct capital infused into the local economies as a result of salaries, expenditures and contractual payment for services rendered in support of installation activities.
