Navy Child & Youth Programs to host Hiring Fair

NORFOLK, VA (NRMA) – Navy Child & Youth Programs will host a Hiring Fair Tuesday, Nov. 1, from 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m., at the Virginia Beach Convention Center.

The Hiring Fair will include on-site qualifications screening, interviews, human resources orientation, and pre-drug and health screenings. Tentative hire letters will be issued the same day.

Eligible applicants must be age 18 and older and all levels of education (high school diploma or GED minimum) will be considered for full-time and flexible direct care Programs Assistant and Programs Leader positions for Child & Youth Programs at Hampton Roads Navy installations. Child & Youth Programs include all ages of care:

- Child Development Centers (6 weeks to 5 years)
- School-Age Care (6 to 12 years)
- Youth Centers (13 to 18 years)

All applicants should bring their resume, a photo identification card, social security card, certifications, high school diploma/GED or college transcripts, three references or letters of recommendation (two professional, one personal), shot records, and bank account and routing numbers for direct deposit payments. Veterans Preference (DD214 required) and Military Spousal Employment Preference (current orders in hand) applicants should arrive between 7:30 to 9 a.m. All others should arrive by 9 a.m.
