

ID Card Guidance

Recently, there have been questions concerning retirees using retired ID cards for base access when reporting to work as a civilian employee or contractor.

In accordance with [DoD Instruction 1000.13, Vol. 1, \(ENCL 2, Pg. 14\)](#) "Individuals shall be issued a separate ID card for each population category for which they qualify. In instances where an individual has been issued more than one ID card (e.g., an individual who is eligible for an ID card as both a Reservist and as a DoD contractor employee), only the ID card that most accurately depicts the capacity in which the individual is affiliated with the DoD should be utilized at any given time." In other words, if an individual is coming on the installation to go to work, he/she should show a Command Access Card, not a retired military card.

Based on this guidance, Naval Station Security personnel will question personnel accessing the installation. Your cooperation is requested.

Motorcycle Training Requirements

Although there is no longer a need for vehicle decals the requirements for operating vehicles on an installation remain the same. One of these requirements is for military personnel to receive motorcycle initial and refresher training.

In accordance with OPNAVINST 5100.12J the responsibility to oversight falls to the activity Commanding Officer and his/her designated motorcycle safety representative.

The following is an overview of requirements:

Licensing. All operators of government and privately-owned motorcycles must be properly licensed or permitted.

Motorcycle Safety Training. The purpose of the Navy motorcycle safety training program is to provide both novice and experienced motorcycle operators with the opportunity to enhance their riding skills, knowledge, and technique throughout their riding career. The program is an effort to reduce mishaps, which in the past have negatively affected readiness.
