**Weapon's Registration** - Navy regulations require that all privately owned weapons brought on board a U.S. Navy installation be registered with Base Security and approved by the Installation Commanding Officer (ICO) BEFORE bringing a weapon on board. For personnel who request Temporary Storage, personnel MUST declare the weapon upon arriving at any Entry Control Point. Personnel residing in government family quarters may keep their weapons at their quarters, AFTER approval of the ICO. Persons residing in the barracks are required to store their weapons with the Base Security Department. All weapons owners desiring to bring a privately owned weapon on board must complete a weapons registration form and documentation relating to the Lautenberg Act. All registrations must be approved by Base Security Forces. Persons found bringing unauthorized weapons on board NCBC will be subject to criminal and administrative penalties to include base debarment and loss of base driving privileges. **For further information, refer to NCBCGPTINST 3593.1.**
