Domestic Violence Awareness Month – Fleet and Family Support Center (FFSC) Gulfport would like to remind you that Domestic violence is defined as a pattern of abusive behavior in any relationship that is used by one partner to gain or maintain power and control over another intimate partner. Domestic violence can include physical, sexual, emotional, economic, psychological actions or threats of actions that influence another person. The color purple of the awareness ribbons is to recognize victims of domestic abuse as well as to celebrate survivors. One physical method of abuse used is strangulation. Strangulation is a behavior often used by domestic abusers and is a silent killer. Under a new Mississippi law, strangulation is a felony. While the terms “strangulation” and “choking” are used interchangeably, they are completely different things. Choking refers to the accidental blockage of the windpipe caused by an object, such as food. Strangulation is the restriction of the flow of blood or oxygen through an intentional strangling act. Strangulation is extremely dangerous and can lead to permanent health problems and death. Strangulation does not always result in visible injuries; therefore, it is important that any victim of strangulation be medically examined immediately.
