Zika Virus Information – Today's edition of the Seabee eCourier contains information provided concerning the Zika virus outbreak. Navy Medicine and the Center for Disease Control (CDC) have provided the below links which contain more extensive details. Until more is known, and out of an abundance of caution, the CDC recommends pregnant women consider postponing travel to any area where Zika virus transmission is occurring - currently the Caribbean, Central America, South America, and Mexico. Pregnant women, or women trying to become pregnant, who do travel to these areas should talk to their healthcare provider first, and they should take strict steps to avoid mosquito bites during the trip. PSD Gulfport note on CAC Cards – As of Feb. 1, Common Access Cards (CACs) are being issued from the new DoD Certificate Authorities (CAs) 33 or 34. If a customer receives a new CAC and reports that it does not function properly, the customer should verify that the CAC is readable on a RAPIDS workstation. If the CAC is readable, the customer will need to contact his or her system administrator or Service Public Key Infrastructure (PKI) Help Desk for certificate support and application compatibility questions. With the new CACs using Certificate Authorities (CAs) 33 or 34, user's may experience issues accessing some sites and programs due to not recognizing the new CAs. If customers desire to renew a CAC and they have sufficient time to wait before issuance of that new CAC, it may be prudent for the customer to wait until the IT systems and PKI support for NMC1/OneNet are updated with the new CAs and delay getting a new CAC. Resolving IT issues with new Certificate Authorities (CAs) issues is an IT support function, not a function of our DEERS/RAPIDS ID Card offices. NPC DEERS/RAPIDS Project Office and CNIC N6 are aware of the issue. **Customers should be referred to their IT support for these issues relating to technical support.**

Register to Vote - If you would like to register to vote, visit fvap.gov now to complete a registration application and request your absentee ballots for the presidential preference primaries (P) and State primaries (S). It only takes a few quick steps to make sure your vote is counted no matter where you are in the world. To register and request your ballots, complete the Federal Post Card Application (FPCA) using the FPCA online assistant (fvap.gov/military-voter/registration-ballots), or fill out the PDF (fvap.gov/uploads/FVAP/Forms/fpca2013.pdf), or pick up a hardcopy version from your Voting Assistance Officer or nearest U.S. Embassy or Consular Office. **The Voting Officer for NCBC Gulfport is Lt.
