Subj: STORM WATER DISCHARGE POLICY

Ref: (a) Federal Clean Water Act Section 402
(b) California Water Code, Division 7, Chapter 5.5
(c) NBSD National Pollution Discharge Elimination System
(NPDES) Permit R9-2009-0100

1. Purpose. Per references (a) and (b), the discharge of storm water effluents to receiving waters of San Diego Bay must comply with the provisions specified in reference (c).

2. Scope. Reference (c) stipulates storm water discharge requirements for site specific areas onboard Naval Base San Diego (NBSD). Processes outlined within these specific areas have associated maximum storm water concentration contaminate levels and toxicity limits which must be met before storm water is discharged.

3. Policy. Prior to discharge of any accumulated storm water effluents to receiving waters that may cause NBSD to be in non-compliance with reference (c), the activity discharging storm water must receive authorization from the Commanding Officer of NBSD.
