Subj: NAVAL DISTRICT WASHINGTON ENERGY POLICY STATEMENT

1. As Commandant, Naval District Washington (NDW), I am committed to building a sustainable energy culture to improve readiness and mission support through the efficient use of energy and enhanced energy security on all NDW installations. The region must embrace these actions and support the Secretary of the Navy's call for a Navy Energy Culture focused on conservation, leadership and behavior change. Judicious use of energy resources must be the daily drumbeat and priority for all hands at all times.

To align and implement this policy, NDW will build and sustain a comprehensive energy strategy framework that provides overall direction for the installations and energy leaders at all levels to support our energy objectives. 3. To provide command and control over this energy strategy framework, the NDW Energy Officer will serve as my touch point on all energy matters aligned with key Energy Manager Partners, the Regional Energy Program Manager, Installation Energy Managers and Building Energy Monitors.

4. All NDW personnel must understand their role and responsibilities to ensure we set the standard for energy excellence in every facet of shore operations.
