

## Exercise Solid Curtain/Citadel Shield 2010

During the week of 22-26 MAR, NSN will participate in Exercise Solid Curtain/Citadel Shield 2010. The SC/CS Exercise Series is an annual CONUS-wide Anti-Terrorism and Force Protection event co-sponsored by United States Fleet Forces Command (USFFC) and Commander, Navy Installations Command. The purpose of the exercise is to demonstrate the capability to counter threats to NSN and exercise the installation anti-terrorism and emergency management plans. There may be traffic delays during the exercise, and tenants may observe more than usual security, fire & emergency services and emergency management activity, including changes in force protection conditions, exercise announcements utilizing Giant Voice and desktop alerts, and placement of barriers."
